



TEEN VOLUNTEER VACCINE PERMISSION

For the safety of our patients Capital Medical Center requires that all new employees and volunteers are evaluated for Tuberculosis (TB) and provide evidence of immunity to the following diseases:

- Mumps
- Measles
- Rubella
- Chicken Pox

We also strongly encourage all volunteers to receive yearly influenza vaccination.

If, upon evaluation of your child's immunization record, an immunization or TB testing is needed, Employee Health will provide that service free of charge. In some cases laboratory testing for immunity may be required.

Consent for Immunization and/or Testing

I give permission for Capital Medical Center Employee Health to (check all that apply):

- Evaluated for Tuberculosis either by a skin test method or a blood draw
- Obtain immunization titers (blood draw) if needed
- Administer vaccines if immunization record not complete
- Administer seasonal Influenza vaccination

I understand that any tests or vaccinations are for informational purposes only and do not give rise to any duty on behalf of Capital Medical Center or its employees to provide further interpretation, diagnostics test or medical services whatsoever. I further understand that there will be no charge for any tests or vaccinations.
